Submission should not exceed 40 typewritten, double-spaced pages. Times Roman 12-point font. Manuscript should be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word or Rich Text Format. Any tables, graphs, or figures should be placed on separate pages and must be submitted in black and white only; figures that are not available in Microsoft Word. Excel or Rich Text Format may be submitted as PDF documents. References should be styled according to APA guidelines. Please also include a brief biographical note for each bylined author, along with postal, email, and telephone contact information.
