Manuscript Specifications: Submissions should not exceed 25 typewritten, double-spaced pages, Times Roman 12-point font. Manuscript should be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word. Any tables, graphs, or figures should be placed on separate pages and must be submitted in black and white only; figures that are not available in Microsoft Word or Excel format may be submitted as PDF documents. References should be styled according to Blue Book guidelines (but may be reformatted before publication).

Required Author Contact Information: Please also include a brief biographical note for each bylined author, along with postal, email, and telephone contact information.
